



## Land Acknowledgement





#### Project History



#### December 2019

The Master Servicing Plan identified the need to ultimately expand the existing WTP to accommodate future water demands of 101 MLD for the Town of Collingwood and its contractual commitments to supply treated water to other municipalities (Town of New Tecumseth, Township of Clearview, and Town of the Blue Mountains).


#### October 2020 & August 2022 (Addendum)


The Schedule C Class Environmental Assessment concluded the need for:

- Phase 1 Expansion from 31 MLD to 59 MLD and future ultimate expansion to 101 MLD
- A new membrane WTP on the existing site.
- Conversion of the existing membrane plant to an administrative building with multiple other processes.








## Extent of Project Work










# Exterior Rendering No. 1 | NE View Membrane and High Lift Buildings















# Interior Rendering No. 1 | NW View Membrane Building Ground Floor









# Interior Rendering No. 2 | NW View Membrane Building Second Floor









Interior Rendering No. 3 | NW View High Lift Buildings





## Budget Update



- Several changes to the scope were identified during the design process based on development pressures, updates to system hydraulics, stakeholder input, and increased concern about the impacts of severe weather events.
- Additional scope costs and significant inflation due to the global pandemic and supply chain disruptions have significantly increased the original opinion of cost.
- Staff Report PW2022-06 with an updated opinion of cost of \$121M for Phase 1 was approved by Council on March 21, 2022.
- Funding for Phase 1 will be provided through the Town's Allocated Water Reserve Fund (funded through water rates), Development Charges, and the establishment of Water Agreements with the customer municipalities.
